SPECIAL LAND USE

Pursuant to the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act (P.A. 110 of 2006), notice is hereby given that the Charter Township of Oxford Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, January 8, 2009 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, at the Oxford Veterans Memorial Civic Center, 28 N. Washington, Second Floor, Oxford, Michigan 48371.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on a proposed Special Land Use (SLU) for a proposed drive-thru banking center at a proposed outlot "C" in the southwest corner of the Meijer property, located on the northeast corner of Lapeer Road (M-24) and Ray Road, known as Parcel # 04-22-200-018.

Drive-In/Drive-Thru Businesses are permitted as special land uses in the C-2 (General Commercial) zoning district in which the subject property is located per (Ordinance 67A, Article 3, Section 3.5 (L) (2)(k).

Documents are available for inspection at the Township Building Department, during normal business hours Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m.

The Charter Township of Oxford will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services, such as signers for the hearing impaired and audiotapes of printed materials being considered at the meeting/hearing.
