**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ZONING ORDINANCE 67A
(Amendment .005)**

Pursuant to the Michigan P.A. 110 of 2006, notice is hereby given that the Charter Township of Oxford Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, March 25, 2010 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, at the Oxford Fire Station # 1, 96 N. Washington, Conference Room, Oxford, Michigan 48371.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comments on proposed amendments to Zoning Ordinance 67A, regarding:

AMENDMENT (.005)

- Article 9 – Signage
 - 9.5 Signs Allowed Without a Permit
 - (D) Flags over right-of-way: Added at the end “with the exception of the United States of America Flag”.
 - (P) Political signs: change to read up only “three (3) days after an election”. (From 10 days)
 - 9.10 (H) Discussion on Help Wanted signs, changed to four (4) weeks at a time, not more than 6 times per calendar year.

Documents are available for inspection at the Township Building Department, during normal business hours Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m.

The Charter Township of Oxford will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services, such as signers for the hearing impaired and audiotapes of printed materials being considered at the meeting/hearing.
