**SYNOPSIS**

Of the Regular Meeting of the Charter Township of Oxford Board of Trustees held on June 14<sup>th</sup> 2006 at the Oxford Veterans Memorial Civic Center.

The following actions were taken:

Approved the agenda as amended.

Approved the following minutes: Special Meeting held May 23, 2006 as presented; Special Meeting held May 24, 2006 as presented; Regular Meeting held May 24, 2006 as presented.

Approved the regular bills through June 8, 2006 with the deletion of 1005A; \$233.21 dated 8/15/04, and change of 11941 and 11951 from General Fund to Trust & Agency and authorized Clerk Sanderson to issue warrants and distribute funds accordingly.

Awarded the bid to Tech Resources for the Data/Computer Cabling Infrastructure in the amount of \$9,430.00.

Adopted a policy that all users of the Oxford Township water system that have water detecto meters be assessed one (1) REU for each detecto meter which will help determine what will be paid toward the Oxford Township Water Bond Debt.

Authorized Treasurer Ferrari to send a letter, per Oxford Township, to all users of the Oxford Township water system that effective July 1, 2006, an assessment will be made of one (1) REU per year for Water Bond Debt purposes.

Awarded the Brabb-Dewey drainage improvements to Roger Ingles Construction in the amount of \$34,542.00.

Approved the fireworks display permit for Jeff Collier as presented.

Requested Treasurer Ferrari to research the cities of Birmingham and Ferndale's governmental units to determine how they levy their PTA penalties and return to the Board for further consideration.

Increased the Oxford Township election worker wages to \$125/day for Inspector and \$150/day for Chairperson effective August 8, 2006.

Authorized Treasurer Ferrari to complete the Restoration of our Trees (ROOT) Program Local Partner Application to serve as a local partner in the northern Oakland County area.

Appointed Charles Kniffen to serve on the Cable Commission for the term of April 23, 2006 thru April 23, 2008.
