Oxford Township Planning Commission

Are you interested in serving your community? Do you want to have a say in the township's present and future development? Do you want to work with others to guide Oxford?

This is your opportunity to be considered for appointment to the Oxford Township Planning Commission. Apply today and your voice could be added to the decision-making process.

If appointed as a planning commissioner, you will be responsible for reviewing and making decisions involving, but not limited to the following:

- Site plans
- Subdivision plans
- Zoning map regulations
- Oxford Township's master plan
- Zoning ordinance additions and amendments

Planning commissioners serve **three-year terms**. If appointed, your term of office will begin on January 1, 2025 and expire on December 31, 2027.

Currently, planning commissioners earn **\$125** for each meeting they attend.

Planning commission meetings are scheduled for the second and fourth Thursdays of the month. Meetings can be cancelled if there's no business to conduct. You will receive a meeting packet several days before each meeting to review. This enables commissioners to be adequately prepared for deliberation and voting.
