Oxford Township Zoning Board of Appeals

Are you interested in serving your community? Do you want to have a say in the township's present and future development? Do you want to work with others to guide Oxford?

This is your opportunity to be considered for appointment to the Oxford Township Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA). Apply today and your voice could be added to the decision-making process.

If appointed as a ZBA member, you will be responsible for reviewing and making decisions involving, but not limited to the following:

- Appeals for variances from Oxford Township Zoning Ordinance 67A
- Appeals of administrative decisions
- Appeals of planning commission decisions
- Carrying out duties and responsibilities as required by the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act

ZBA members serve **three-year terms**. If appointed, your term of office will begin on January 1, 2025 and expire on December 31, 2027.

Currently, zoning board of appeals members earn **\$125** for each meeting they attend.

ZBA meetings are scheduled for the second Monday of the month. Meetings can be cancelled if there's no business to conduct. You will receive a meeting packet several days before each meeting to review. This enables ZBA members to be adequately prepared for deliberation and voting.
